The CCSP is a voluntary program designed to enable vetted, validated, and certified supply chain facilities to screen air cargo prior to delivering the cargo to the air carrier. The CCSP will create additional screening capacity and provide a practical, effective opportunity for screening to occur on individual pieces of cargo prior to consolidation.
