

ITAR Export Compliance Training

Many defense products require U.S. export licenses even if not directly exported. For example, if your component or part is adapted or modified and assembled into another company's military aircraft destined for export, your product falls under the jurisdiction of the **International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR)** and your company is subject to trade controls. It is your responsibility to be aware of the law. Failure to comply, even unknowingly, is subject to severe penalties.

If you are concerned, want to know more, or want reassurance that you are in compliance, we have a training program to guide you through all the requirements and procedures.

The El Camino Center for International Trade Development (CITD) offers low-cost export compliance training. A federal government grant enables us to subsidize the otherwise much higher costs. The ITAR training will be conducted by Mr. Ashok Sadhwani, a specialist with expert knowledge of the State Department's ITAR. Mr. Sadhwani has over 25 years of experience and is the President of Asmara U.S.A., Inc., an international trade compliance management consultancy firm.

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TRAINING:

Through this training you will acquire a distinctive applicability of ITAR to your company's export operations. It provides an analysis and straightforward interpretation of the regulations – 22CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) Parts 120-130. Focus is placed on business units dealing with contracts, legal, customer service, material planning, shipping, sales and order entry. Training is limited to the first 15 individuals who sign up so that adequate attention can be given to each participant. The registration fee, covering all course materials and lunch, is \$100 per person.
